 - 1. Winterfest 2014: Parents were happy, everyone fit on the blacktop, parking was not a problem

 - i. Amy:
 - 1. Good start to the New Year
 - 2. Smart Board installation has begun: 1 of the 4 is installed
 - 3. Winterfest was a success
 - c. Principal
 - i. Jeff:
 - 1. Any questions on Principal's Report?
 - 2. Classroom computers- Hawaiian Hope has not delivered the computers yet due to a family emergency at Hawaiian Hope
 - 3. Arts Integration Professional Development with Evan Anderson in Washington, D.C: February 4-6.
 - 4. New iPad set with keyboards: come with standard 1 year warranty

- 5. Donors Choose: Has provided \$7000 in tangible items and \$1700 in cash
- 6. Subfinder: Webbased system to track absences/vacation days in a "live" format for faculty
 - Teachers can electronically submit an absence and Subfinder will transmit automated calls/emails to find a preferred substitute
 - b. Cost: ~\$1750/year (\$1000 upfront (training included), ~\$175 per month, summer free)
- 7. Special Education teacher on suspension
 - a. DOE has emailed to inform last day to hire someone is the end of March. A replacement can potentially be found
 - i. Currently, even without a replacement, all Special Education and IEP needs are being met

III. Finances

- a. Joni:
 - i. Profit: good, but still awaiting some expenses that haven't come in yet
 - ii. Finance Policies: All required policies are currently on the website, but additional policies can be added, if needed
 - iii. Property and Insurance Liability: older policies need to be looked at, considering new location, technology upgrades, etc...
 - a. Landlord responsible for some repairs.
 - b. Joni will meet with colleague to relook at current policies and facility
 - iv. Facilities: 3 new water leaks found. Water expenses will continue to be monitored
 - Voyager Debit/Credit Card for Jeff: \$1000/day limit, anything over \$500 needs approval. All transactions visible in bank statements and itemized receipts will be provided.
- b. Jeff:
 - i. EZSchoolPay: an online portal for parents to pay and view balances and transactions, notifying users of low balances and use.
 - a. Parents can submit payment for field trips, uniforms, lunches, and more online. Checks will still be accepted as a form of payment.
 - b. \$21K loss from meals (beyond Free & Reduced) is a current problem that can be improved with EZSchoolPay

 - i. Status of asbestos: confirmed. Full report available

- Currently no estimate/quote available for removal of asbestos.
 Original notice from Department of Health left little notice to plan budget
 - a. Two companies are bidding now-need a third.
- 2. Shirley: Lease requires tenant to inspect for any hazardous materials prior to move in. Upon move-in, tenant accepts presence of hazardous materials
- 3. Department of Health will advise how to proceed

 - 1. Volunteers will be cleaning, painting, and making small repairs
 - 2. Neil requests the Principal and faculty to provide input as to what they would like accomplished
