The choice to enroll my child at Voyager School is based upon my desire to become an active partner in the education of my child.

As a parent of a student at Voyager School, my commitment is to:

2. Recognize and embrace my role as having primary responsibility for the education of my child/children.
3. Bring my child(ren) to school on time and ready to learn. This includes preparing them for learning by making sure they get a good night's sleep (10-12 hours required for little ones) and good nutrition.
4. Attend all conferences (student-led, parent teacher, or other conferences as needed) and recharge Sessions.
5. Actively participate in the Voyager volunteer program.
6. Participate in school-sponsored meetings, activities and annual recharge sessions.
7. Read and follow the Voyager Parent/Student Handbook.
8. Read and act on information sent home by the school to keep parents informed of events, policies, meetings, etc.
9. Complete and return surveys as a way of providing feedback to the school about my child and his/her learning.

### **SCHOOL TOURS AND INFORMATION SESSIONS ARE MANDATORY FOR INTERESTED FAMILIES**

Interested families are required to attend a school tour **AND** information session prior to accepting an available student position. Tours are held in the morning while school is in session. Information presentations are designed for adults and child care is not provided, so we encourage families to come without children. We believe that the decision to enroll a child in a particular program should be made by well-informed parents who agree with and support the program philosophy. Later in the school year we will be having a visitation day specifically designed for children so that interested families can bring them to see the school at that time. **Please call the main office at 521-9770 to schedule a school tour.**
